

Child belongings Policy

Children should be safe to come to nursery and enjoy their time. Children should only bring essential items to nursery with them and Parents/Carers should be aware of the types of unsuitable items that could be brought into nursery and prevent this from happening.

In particular, we recommend parents do not send their children to nursery in best clothes as they are likely to get dirty and have marks. The nursery uniform is reasonably priced and parents are asked to purchase nursery uniform so children get used to going to school in uniform.

Please note that we need to ensure children's health and safety and the safety of others. Parents/Carers also need to be aware that the nursery does not take responsibility if a child's clothing becomes dirty and marked. We highly recommend parents to name their child's clothes

We do not recommend children bring their toys from home to the nursery as they are likely to be lost and we will not be held responsible. In particular, please do not send:

- Any sharp objects
- Sweets, chewing gum, nuts, drinks, food
- Money
- Smoking items or Vapes
- Toys and games consoles
- Anything that might cause fire
- Mobile phones
- Creams and lip balms
- Keys
- Medication

This is not an exhaustive list - please ask if you are unsure.
